Patient-centered care: We will form a close relationship with you and your child. Your health care team will also work with you and your child to set attainable goals that fit comfortably into your daily life.

Comprehensive care: Our medical team will focus on more than your child's physical health. We will also work to meet all mental and emotional needs, including preventative and well care.

Coordinated care: Should your child ever need specialty services, or have a medical emergency, CCP will coordinate care between medical professionals.

Access to care: CCP pediatric providers are available in office or by phone 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Convenient office hours and flexible scheduling, along with Walk-in Service, Children's Express Care and Children's Nurse Triage & Advice Line, give you access to pediatric care when you need it most.
